The role requires a professional with **3-5 Years** of relevant experience who can take ownership of assigned work from concept development through production, review, revision and final delivery. The selected candidate will be expected to follow approved creative directions, maintain organised project workflows, document progress, communicate professionally and coordinate effectively with internal teams working across **Gaya** and other operational markets.

As a **Fully Remote** role based in **Gaya**, the employee must maintain a professional virtual setup, including a suitable laptop or desktop, stable high-speed internet, a distraction-controlled workspace and availability during assigned working hours. These qualities should be reflected in the ability to interpret briefs accurately, identify production issues, make practical creative decisions and maintain quality standards under defined timelines. Through responsible execution, structured communication and dependable collaboration, the **AI-Generated Video & Motion Graphics Designer** will contribute to the continued development of **Moris Media's** creative and digital service operations.

Primary Responsibilities

Based in **Gaya** and operating under a **Remote work** model, the AI-Generated Video & Motion Graphics Designer

will be responsible for delivering high-quality, AI-assisted visual content by combining creative thinking, technical expertise and structured production workflows. The role involves managing the complete creative lifecycle, from understanding project requirements and developing AI-generated visual assets to motion graphics, video editing, post-production, quality assurance and final delivery. Working closely with cross-functional teams, the selected professional will ensure that every creative output aligns with business objectives, approved brand guidelines, technical specifications and professional production standards while maintaining consistent communication, organised workflows and timely project execution.

Your primary responsibilities will include:

- **1. Develop AI-Generated Video Content:** Create role-specific AI-generated videos for digital campaigns, social media, brand communication, presentations and client requirements while maintaining visual accuracy, narrative clarity and approved production standards.

Required Skills

The ideal candidate should possess a balanced combination of creative ability, technical expertise and professional production knowledge, with the capability to independently manage end-to-end video production workflows while maintaining high standards of quality, consistency and visual accuracy. Based in **Gaya**, the selected professional should demonstrate strong ownership, effective communication and the ability to collaborate efficiently within a structured remote working environment.

AI Video Generation & Prompt Engineering

Demonstrate strong expertise in AI-powered video generation using text-to-video, image-to-video and AI-assisted animation workflows. Develop structured prompts that accurately define subjects, environments, lighting, composition, camera movement, visual style, scene continuity and production quality while continuously refining outputs to improve consistency, realism and overall creative quality.

Professional Video Editing & Post-Production

Possess advanced video editing capabilities with a solid understanding of storytelling, pacing, sequencing and audience engagement. Produce professionally edited videos by integrating AI-generated content, voiceovers, music, graphics and multimedia assets while applying colour correction, colour grading, compositing, motion tracking, masking, stabilization, transitions and export optimisation.

Motion Graphics & Visual Animation

Design high-quality motion graphics that enhance communication through animated typography, logo animations, title sequences, branded transitions, infographics, presentation graphics, user interface animations and other visual elements while maintaining consistency with approved brand standards.

AI Image Generation & Visual Development

Create production-ready AI-generated images for concept development, storyboards, character references, environments, product visualisations and creative compositions. Maintain visual consistency through effective composition, lighting, aspect ratio planning, image enhancement, inpainting, outpainting, upscaling and preparation for video production workflows.

Storyboarding & Creative Planning

Interpret creative briefs and scripts to develop structured storyboards, scene breakdowns, shot planning, transition sequences, camera movement strategies and production workflows that support efficient execution and minimise revisions throughout the production process.

Brand Implementation & Visual Consistency

Apply approved brand guidelines accurately across all creative outputs by maintaining consistency in logo usage, typography, colour systems, visual hierarchy, animation behaviour and overall brand identity to ensure every deliverable meets professional quality standards.

Audio Editing & Sound Production

Demonstrate sound knowledge of audio production by synchronising voiceovers, selecting suitable background music, integrating sound effects, balancing audio levels, improving dialogue clarity, reducing unwanted noise and producing professional audio that complements the visual content.

Quality Assurance & Production Standards

Maintain exceptional attention to detail by reviewing all deliverables for visual inconsistencies, rendering issues, continuity errors, branding inaccuracies, synchronisation problems, typography errors, resolution defects and export quality before final submission.

Collaboration, Communication & Project Coordination

Work effectively with creative professionals, content teams, designers, project managers and stakeholders to understand project objectives, communicate progress, implement feedback, manage multiple assignments simultaneously and deliver high-quality creative outputs within agreed timelines while maintaining professional accountability and organised documentation.

Qualifications & Experience

motion graphics, video editing, post-production, visual communication, digital media, animation or a related creative field. Based in **Gaya**, candidates should demonstrate the ability to deliver commercially viable creative work while maintaining structured production workflows, professional standards and consistent quality. Relevant industry experience is preferred; however, candidates with exceptional technical expertise, a strong portfolio and proven AI-assisted production capabilities will also be considered.

They should be capable of selecting the most appropriate AI platform according to project objectives, creative requirements, production quality and production efficiency rather than relying on a single solution.

AI Platforms & Workflow Knowledge

Applicants should possess working knowledge of leading AI video generation platforms such as Google Veo, Seedance-2, Runway, Kling AI, Luma Dream Machine, Pika, Adobe Firefly Video, Hailuo AI, PixVerse and Haiper. Expertise across every platform is not mandatory; however, candidates should understand the strengths, limitations and appropriate production use cases of multiple industry-recognised AI tools.

Prompt Interpretation & Production Evaluation

The successful candidate should understand how AI platforms interpret prompts, reference images, camera controls, motion instructions and visual styles. They should be capable of evaluating generated content based on realism, cinematic quality, prompt accuracy, character consistency, motion precision, rendering quality, output resolution and commercial production suitability while determining whether outputs require refinement or regeneration.

Advanced AI Production Techniques

Practical experience with reference-image conditioning, keyframe-guided generation, start-and-end frame control, motion brushes, scene extension, video inpainting, object replacement, background replacement, lip synchronisation and character consistency workflows will be considered a strong advantage.

Creative & Technical Capabilities

In addition to AI production expertise, candidates should demonstrate strong capabilities in professional video editing, motion graphics, visual storytelling, prompt engineering, AI image generation, sound design, storyboarding, colour correction, colour grading, compositing and brand implementation. They should be capable of independently managing the complete creative production lifecycle while consistently delivering technically accurate, visually refined and production-ready content.

Portfolio Expectations

Applicants should present a professional portfolio showcasing AI-generated videos, corporate films, motion graphics, promotional campaigns, product demonstrations, brand films, social media campaigns and other creative projects that demonstrate both technical proficiency and creative execution.
